



Current OEM Emergency Operations:
No Active OEM Operation

The OEM Duty Officer is on standby to provide support and coordination to any emergency condition that could impact the City of Amarillo, Potter County, and/or Randall County



Current OEM Emergency Operations:
OEM FIELD OPERATIONS

Emergency Administration/OEM personnel have been activated to support and coordinate emergency operations in the community. These operations may include airport alerts, hazardous materials spills, large fires, law enforcement operations, or other emergency incidents that have occurred in the community.



Current OEM Emergency Operations:
STATE OR REGIONAL MONITORING

Key City and County personnel have staffed the EOC to monitor state or regional emergency operations that do not have a direct impact on the City of Amarillo, Potter County, or Randall County, but may require assistance from interjurisdictional area.



Current OEM Emergency Operations:
FIRE WEATHER MONITORING

Extreme fire weather conditions (NWS Red Flag Warning conditions; RH<15%; winds>30 mph) are impacting the City of Amarillo, Potter County, and Randall County. OEM Duty Officer and AFD staff are maintaining situational awareness of conditions, status of emergency response resources, and are pre-positioned to support and coordinate response if necessary.



Current OEM Emergency Operations:
WINTER WEATHER MONITORING

Extreme winter weather conditions (consistent with NWS blowing snow or blizzard advisories/warnings) are threatening or impacting the City of Amarillo, Potter County, and/or Randall County. Limited activation of the EOC is in place to maintain situational awareness of weather conditions & is pre-positioned to support & coordinate response if necessary.



Current OEM Emergency Operations:

SEVERE WEATHER MONITORING

Severe weather (consistent with NWS Severe Thunderstorm Warning criteria) is threatening or impacting the City of Amarillo, Potter County, and/or Randall County. OEM Duty Officer is maintaining situational awareness of weather conditions, is pre-positioned to activate warning, & available to support and coordinate response if necessary.



Current OEM Emergency Operations:

WEATHER WATCH

Severe weather (consistent with NWS Severe Thunderstorm Warning criteria with a potential to have a threat) is threatening or impacting the City of Amarillo, Potter County, and/or Randall County. A limited activation of the EOC with full cadre of storm spotters is in place to maintain situational awareness of weather conditions, is pre-positioned to activate warning, and available to support and coordinate response if necessary.



Current OEM Emergency Operations:

AIRPORT EOC ACTIVATION

An airport alert for a major aircraft accident has been initiated. The Airport EOC is activated to support and coordinate emergency operations for the incident.



Current OEM Emergency Operations:

LIMITED EOC ACTIVATION

The EOC is activated with designated personnel to provide policy direction, support field emergency response, and coordinate the overall emergency response and recovery efforts to a major emergency incident that is impacting the City of Amarillo, Potter County, and Randall County.



Current OEM Emergency Operations:

FULL EOC ACTIVATION

The EOC is fully activated to provide policy direction, support field emergency response, and coordinate the overall emergency response and recovery efforts to a major emergency incident that is impacting the City of Amarillo, Potter County, and Randall County.
