### WILLOWCREEK SOUTH COMPLEX FIRE & TANGLEWOOD COMPLEX FIRE DAMAGE ASSESSMENT SUMMARY INFORMATION

The Amarillo/Potter/Randall Office of Emergency Management has completed the initial damage assessment of areas impacted by the February 27, 2011 wildfires in Potter County and Randall County. This information will be included in a Disaster Summary Outline (DSO) that will be submitted to the State of Texas along with continued requests for assistance to individuals impacted by these extreme wildfires.
